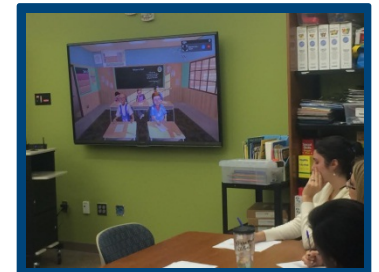
### How many credits do you have to take a semester to qualify as a full time student?

Admission requirements are:

- Application fee
- Completed application forms
- GRE Scores completed in the last five years
- Official transcripts for all prior universities attended
- 3 letters of recommendations
- Resume
- Statement of purpose
