



SELF Design Studio Material Use Policies and Prices

Effective January 1, 2018

Use of materials and resources in the SDS is reserved for students, faculty, and staff of the School of Education (unless otherwise stated during a specific event or workshop). Priority will be given to students completing projects for class assignments.

Projects completed for class assignments should adhere to the following material use policies:

- Projects on the laser engraver should use cardboard whenever possible
- If necessary, laser engraver projects can be made using wood - with a maximum of one 12x24" MDF board per project
- Use of the 3D printers should be limited to a maximum of 5 hours of print time
- If multiple students have projects to be printed on the 3D printer or laser engraver at the same time, a "print queue" will be established and jobs will be completed on a first come, first served basis
- Recycle! Whenever possible, reuse materials from an old project and save your extras for future students

Personal projects that are not for class assignments are subject to the following fees for materials and equipment use:

Cardboard	\$1 per 12x24" sheet
MDF wood	\$5 per 12x24" board
Wood laminates	\$10 per 12x24" board
Laser machine usage	\$5 per 15 minutes
3D printed items	Any project weighing 10 grams or less is \$5. Projects over 10 grams are 50 cents per gram.
3D printer usage	\$5 for 1st hour / \$2 each additional
Cricut materials	\$3 per vinyl sheet / \$1 per paper sheet (up to 12x12" size)
